Information included in voter registration records, including linked information about a voter's name, age, address, and phone numbers, can be publicized and used in ways that could promote harassment of registered voters, promote identity theft, promote discrimination on the basis of age or political party, and that might ultimately discourage citizens from registering to vote. I strongly encourage you to do what you can to get HB 7392 passed.
