Regarding House Joint Resolution No. 161 on accommodations for early voting in Connecticut, I wish to be on record in support of such an amendment to our State Constitution. I suspect numerous examples can be found of citizens who encounter great difficulty in appearing in person on one select day out of the year that is not presently a federal holiday. Reasons might include fundamental challenges in daily routine or temporary accidental circumstances beyond one's control. I believe that expanding voting options, whether through adding days to appear in person, or making absentee ballots less restrictive and more commonplace could only enhance fulfilling the peoples' right to vote, and have their voice heard in our representative form of government. I also believe creative minds can find ways to make this possible without significant additional cost burden in the election process. Thank you for allowing my opinion to be expressed.
