REASONS FOR BILL:

This bill was referred to the Public Safety Committee from the Planning and Development Committee.

In the Public Safety Committee sections 12,13,14, and 15 were removed from the bill. This removes language dealing with Promoting Consolidation of Public Service Answering Points (PSAPs), which would promote the merger of 60 single town PSAPs with populations of less than 40,000 by providing additional transition grant money from the Emergency 9-1-1 program to defray the costs of consolidation. Additionally it removes the section decreasing the number of mandated inspections by fire marshals.
