REASONS FOR BILL:

A public official and state employee who is required to file a statement of Financial Interest must identify certain assets and liabilities held by him or her, the official's or employee's spouse and dependent children who reside in their household. The bill exempts the names of dependent children residing in the filer's household from public disclosure under the freedom of information act.

RESPONSE FROM ADMINISTRATION/AGENCY:

Carol Carson, Executive, Director State of Connecticut, Office of State Ethics: This bill increases the protection and safety of dependent children, the names of such children will not be available for public information. This bill has bi-partisan support.
