Judiciary Committee,

Please allow me to comment on the following proposed bills:

**SB 60**

I oppose this bill. This bill will allow law enforcement to ask to see a persons permit to carry for no reason. I consider this an infringement on my second amendments rights. It should not be allowed. I ask you to please oppose this bill.

**SB 940**

I support this bill. I support unrestricted carry for purposes of self defense. I ask you to pass this bill.

**HB 5227**

I oppose this bill. Allowing every city and town to make laws that restrict law abiding citizens right to self defense would be punitive. There are too many laws on the books now. We do not need more. I ask you to oppose this bill.

**HB 5870**

I support this bill. There should not be restrictions on transferring weapons between individuals who possess identical qualifications to own an assault weapon and large capacity magazine. I ask that you please pass this bill.

**HB 7218**

I oppose this bill. This bill negatively impacts a person's ability to self defense at home. This could cause a delay which could be deadly. Criminals will not wait in order to provide a fair fight. Offering firearm safety classes in schools could help kids better understand the serious nature of firearms. I ask you to oppose this bill.

**HB 7219**

I oppose this bill. This bill intends to punish passionate gun owners who like to build from kits. Requiring serial numbers is a form of registry which leads to confiscation. A gun with a serial number that was reported stolen does nothing to improve safety. I ask you to oppose this bill.

**HB 7223**

I oppose this bill. I support unrestricted carry as defined in the second amendment. Having to lock your weapon in a safe in your car is unreasonable. I suspect that the majority of guns stolen from cars are guns owned by criminals stolen by other criminals. It seems to me this bill tries to address a very small problem. Its impact on law abiding citizens is unacceptable to me. Please oppose this bill.
