My neighbor's nephew was killed at Sandy Hook. I have neighbors, family members and friends who have been killed and hurt by gun violence. My son works in the emergency department at a large city hospital. The two most frequent trauma events he treats are motorcycle crashes and gun shots. We have to drastically reduce violent (and self-inflicted) gun use. This is only a baby-step towards reduction in gun crimes, but it is an important step. Passage of this bill creates no undue burden on anyone and it will help keep all of us safer.
