I am writing today to voice my opposition to **HB 7005 AN ACT PROHIBITING THE ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PARENTAL STATEMENTS CONCERNING RELIGIOUS OBJECTIONS TO VACCINATION BY SCHOOL NURSES AND PERMITTING MEMBERS OF THE CLERGY TO ACKNOWLEDGE SUCH STATEMENTS**. The language is not clear and sounds like a violation of our First Amendment. I have freedom to religious choice, organized or not, the state cannot tell me which religious clergy can and cannot sign a Religious Exemption.

Again, I respectfully oppose. It is our RIGHT to have freedom of choice in religion and health. The vaccination schedule NOT a one size fits all approach.
