

**Testimony Presented Before the Committee On Children  
February 7, 2019**

**House Bill 7005 - An Act Prohibiting The Acknowledgment Of Parental Statements  
Concerning Religious Objections To Vaccination By School Nurses And Permitting Members  
Of The Clergy To Acknowledge Such Statements.**

**1) This proposed legislative change is unnecessary, unwarranted and completely inappropriate.**

The current religious exemption from vaccinations in order to attend public school states that if in the event of a vaccine preventable illness, the child will stay home from school for the duration of the illness.
