### **SB 972, An Act Concerning Access to Original Birth Certificates by Adult Adopted Persons**

Planning & Development Committee

Good morning Senator Cassano, Representative McCarthy Vahey, Senator Champagne, Representative Zawistowski and the distinguished members of the Planning & Development Committee, thank you for affording me the opportunity to submit this testimony on **SB 972 An Act Concerning Access to Original Birth Certificates by Adult Adopted Persons**. My name is Mark Bernacki. I am the Town Clerk of New Britain and the Legislative Chair of the Connecticut Town Clerks Association.

Town Clerks are responsible for maintaining the vital records (birth, marriage and death) of our towns and support legislation to allow adoptees to receive an UNCERTIFIED copy of their original birth certificate. We have met with the leadership of the Planning & Development Committee as well as Karen Caffrey, President of Access Connecticut Now, Inc. on this issue of access to original birth records by adult adopted persons and support SB 972 as approved by the committee (LCO 6520). The timeframe and fees associated with all written requests for these vital records will be identical to current law.
