Are you aware that the Academy of Adoption and Assisted Reproduction Attorneys has a new resolution supporting OBC access? Passed in January 2018, among other things, it says:

"THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, that the Academy of Adoption and Assisted Reproduction Attorneys supports the inherent rights of adult adopted persons to their personal biological family information and to have access to their:

1. original birth certificates;
2. agency records which relate to them and their biological family; and
3. court records of their adoption."

Please contact your local judges and legislators and let them know about this resolution passed by the entity which created closed records. They have reversed themselves!
