

1. There is zero chance for my child to either contract or spread HPV while in school, therefore it should not be a mandated vaccine.

2. Direct quote from the Gardasil insert: "Because vaccinees may develop syncope, sometimes resulting in falling with injury, observation for 15 minutes after administration is recommended. Syncope, sometimes associated with tonicclonic movements and other seizure-like activity, has been reported following vaccination with GARDASIL. When syncope is associated with tonic-clonic movements, the activity is usually transient and typically responds to restoring cerebral perfusion by maintaining a supine or Trendelenburg position. (5.1)" Therefore I would not want my child to ever receive this vaccine (or any other) at a school or pharmacy or doctor's office without my presence.

3. I would support a bill that said people aged 16 and up could receive vaccines without parental consent. 12 is too young.

4. There is no reason to change the waiver. To add clergy violates religious freedom (not all religions have clergy) and violates HIPAA because it forces a family to share medical information outside of the medical profession. The school nurse is a medical professional, and far more qualified to verify.
