

I am writing to strongly oppose SB94: AN ACT ALLOWING PHARMACISTS TO ADMINISTER THE INFLUENZA VACCINE TO CHILDREN TWELVE YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.

They should not be permitted to walk into any pharmacy and request a flu vaccine, particularly without a parent present. Pharmacists may not be aware of a child's medical history.
