**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A LIMIT ON THE VALUE OF GIFTS
PHYSICIANS MAY ACCEPT FROM DRUG MANUFACTURERS AND
WHOLESALEERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any physician
- 2 licensed under chapter 370 of the general statutes, or any member of
- 3 the physician's family, from accepting anything of value in excess of
- 4 ten dollars, except drug samples, from a manufacturer or wholesaler of
- 5 drugs, or any representative of such manufacturer or wholesaler.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a limit on the value of gifts physicians and their families may accept from manufacturers and wholesalers of drugs.
