**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT CLEAN SLATE LAW.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-142a of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 provide for the automatic sealing of a person's criminal record for any
- 3 misdemeanor offense and certain felony offenses seven years after the
- 4 date of a final judgment resulting in the person's conviction for such
- 5 offense, and (2) make any criminal record sealed in accordance with
- 6 subdivision (1) of this section accessible only by law enforcement
- 7 agencies.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide for the automatic sealing of a person's criminal record for certain offenses after seven years.
