AN ACT PROHIBITING THE AWARDING OF GOOD TIME CREDITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 320 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 persons currently eligible to collect the good time credits that were
- 3 abolished in public act 93-219 because they were sentenced prior to the
- 4 passage of this legislation from collecting such credits going forward.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit persons who were sentenced prior to the abolishment of good time credits in 1993 from continuing to collect such credits.
