**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY RANKED-
CHOICE VOTING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study the implementation at
- 2 elections of a method of casting and tabulating votes in which (1)
- 3 voters rank candidates in order of preference, (2) tabulation proceeds
- 4 in sequential rounds in which last-place candidates are defeated and
- 5 until one candidate receives over fifty per cent of the votes cast, and (3)
- 6 the candidate receiving over fifty per cent of the votes cast is deemed
- 7 to have been elected to such office.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a task force to study ranked-choice voting.
