**AN ACT CONCERNING DISCLOSURE OF PRESIDENTIAL AND
GUBERNATORIAL CANDIDATES' FEDERAL TAX RETURNS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that no
- 2 candidate for President or Vice President of the United States, or
- 3 Governor or Lieutenant Governor, may appear on any primary or
- 4 general election ballot unless such candidate publicly discloses his or
- 5 her tax returns for at least the past two years.

Statement of Purpose:

To require presidential and gubernatorial candidates to publicly
disclose a minimum of their past two years' worth of tax returns in
order to gain access to the primary and general election ballots.
