AN ACT MODIFYING REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR DETOXIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That sections 38a-492p and 38a-518p of the general statutes be
2 amended to require health insurance coverage for (1) not more than
3 seven days of detoxification per admission, (2) not fewer than four
4 admissions for inpatient detoxification per lifetime, (3) not fewer than
5 thirty days of residential treatment services during any year, (4) not
6 fewer than ninety days of nonhospital residential treatment services
7 per lifetime, (5) not fewer than thirty sessions of outpatient or partial
8 hospitalization services during any year, (6) not fewer than one
9 hundred twenty sessions of outpatient or partial hospitalization
10 services per lifetime, (7) family counseling and intervention services,
11 and (8) not fewer than thirty additional outpatient or partial
12 hospitalization sessions per lifetime, which may be exchanged on a
13 two-to-one basis to provide fifteen additional nonhospital residential
14 treatment days.

Statement of Purpose:

To modify required health insurance coverage for detoxification.
