AN ACT CONCERNING AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER'S ABILITY TO ACCESS AN ANIMAL IN DISTRESS IN A PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 52-557u of the general statutes be amended to ensure
- 2 that an animal control officer, in the course of performing his or her
- 3 official duties, may access a passenger motor vehicle, including
- 4 accessing such vehicle by force, to assist an animal in distress.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow an animal control officer, when performing his or her official duties, to gain access to an animal in distress in a passenger motor vehicle.
