**AN ACT CONCERNING CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS LICENSED OR CERTIFIED AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL BUT WHO ARE NOT EMPLOYED AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to exempt from
- 2 continuing education requirements any person who is licensed or
- 3 certified as emergency medical services personnel, but who is not
- 4 employed as emergency medical services personnel, until such time as
- 5 such person reenters active employment as emergency medical
- 6 services personnel, at which time such person shall only be required to
- 7 complete the continuing education requirements for the year he or she
- 8 reenters employment and any year thereafter during which such
- 9 person remains employed as emergency medical services personnel.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow for an exemption to continuing education requirements for certain emergency medical services personnel.
