**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STATE-WIDE  
PLAN FOR RESPONDING TO LARGE SCALE SCHOOL CRISIS  
EVENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Education to develop a state-wide plan for responding
- 3 to large scale school crisis events and that such plan shall include, but
- 4 need not be limited to, cooperation with other education and
- 5 behavioral health agencies, provisions specifying short and long-term
- 6 interventions for different student populations and identifying
- 7 funding mechanisms that will minimize discontinuity of services.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Department of Education to develop a state-wide plan for responding to large scale school crisis events.
