AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF EPINEPHRINE IN PUBLIC VENUES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize public venues,
- 2 including, but not limited to, restaurants, youth organizations' sports
- 3 facilities, theme parks, sports arenas and day care facilities, to stock
- 4 and make available trained nonmedical staff to administer emergency
- 5 epinephrine in cartridge injectors to individuals who are experiencing
- 6 anaphylactic symptoms.

Statement of Purpose:

To make emergency epinephrine in cartridge injectors more widely available to people who suffer anaphylactic symptoms in public venues.
