## AN ACT REQUIRING REEVALUATION OF SCHOOL SECURITY AND SAFETY PLAN STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-222n of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to
- 3 reevaluate school security and safety plan standards every three years
- 4 and make such standards available to all schools through the
- 5 Department of Education.
