***AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FLAME RETARDANT
CHEMICALS IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS AND UPHOLSTERED
RESIDENTIAL FURNITURE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the sale and
- 2 distribution of children's products, except infant car seats, and
- 3 upholstered residential furniture containing organohalogen flame
- 4 retardant chemicals, provided such prohibition takes effect at a later
- 5 date to provide a reasonable enough time for the industry to adopt
- 6 such changes.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the sale and distribution of children's products containing flame retardant chemicals.
