**AN ACT REQUIRING PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURERS TO
OFFER COVERAGE FOR THE REMOVAL OF TREES FROM
RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700 of the general statutes be amended to require each
- 2 insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, renews, amends or endorses a
- 3 homeowners insurance policy for a residential property in this state to
- 4 offer coverage for the removal of trees from such property that have
- 5 fallen onto such property due to a natural disaster.
