**AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN STATE AND MUNICIPAL WORKERS  
AND FIRST RESPONDERS TO FILE WORKERS' COMPENSATION  
CLAIMS FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED WHILE TRAVELING TO AND  
FROM WORK.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To allow emergency management service, dispatch, fire, police and
- 2 emergency management personnel who are employed by the state or a
- 3 municipality thereof to file a workers' compensation claim for injuries
- 4 sustained on the way to work or on the way home from work.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To protect certain workers and first responders by allowing them to file workers' compensation claims for injuries sustained while traveling to and from work.
