AN ACT FUNDING THE STATE-WIDE FIREARMS TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE BY REDUCING CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM GRANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to reduce Citizens' Election
- 2 Program grant amounts for legislative candidates by ten per cent and
- 3 that those funds be redirected to the Department of Emergency
- 4 Services and Public Protection for the purpose of restoring funding to
- 5 the state-wide firearms trafficking task force, established pursuant to
- 6 section 29-38e of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to the state-wide firearms trafficking task force and prevent deaths from illegally trafficked firearms.
