AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF VICTIM SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a working
2 group to study victim services. Such study shall include, but not be
3 limited to, an examination of services provided to a victim of a crime
4 starting from the point of the commission of the crime and continuing
5 to the point that such person no longer needs such services. The study
6 shall include any recommendations for legislation to improve, enhance
7 or streamline the provision of such services.

8 (b) The working group shall consist of the following members:

9 (1) The Victim Advocate, or the Victim Advocate's designee;

10 (2) A municipal police chief appointed by the Connecticut Police
11 Chiefs Association;

12 (3) The Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection,
