**AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENTS THROUGH CERTAIN  
HIGH-DEDUCTIBLE HEALTH PLANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require that each
- 2 health carrier that issues a high-deductible plan directly reimburse
- 3 each participating provider for the cost of a covered benefit regardless
- 4 of whether such health carrier has received payment for the deductible
- 5 due to such health carrier under such plan.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require that each health carrier that issues a high-deductible plan directly reimburse each participating provider for the cost of a covered benefit regardless of whether such health carrier has received payment for the deductible due to such health carrier under such plan.
