AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO A COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL COUNSELING PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the State
- 2 Board of Education, in consultation with the Connecticut School
- 3 Counselor Association, to adopt guidelines and recommendations that
- 4 ensure that all students have access to a comprehensive school
- 5 counseling program that includes manufacturing, trade, academic,
- 6 social-emotional and post-secondary and career readiness
- 7 programming delivered by a certified school counselor who has
- 8 received adequate training.
