AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF A GUIDE DOG OR ASSISTANCE DOG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 46a-44 and 46a-64 of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to provide that a blind person using a guide dog or a deaf or mobility
- 3 impaired person using an assistance dog may not be required to
- 4 disclose the reason for use of the dog as a condition of bringing the
- 5 dog onto public transportation or into a place of public
- 6 accommodation.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit asking an individual the reason for using a guide dog or assistance dog as a condition of bringing the dog onto public transportation or into a place of public accommodation.
