AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPUNGEMENT OF CRIMINAL RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 54 of the general statutes be amended to create a system of
- 2 expungement of criminal records for offenders who have remained
- 3 offense-free for a significant period following the end of his or her
- 4 sentence.
