**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FOUNDATION TO RECEIVE DONATIONS  
FOR THE ROBERTA B. WILLIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That (1) title 10a of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 foundation for the purpose of collecting donations from businesses
- 3 and individuals for the benefit of the Roberta B. Willis Scholarship
- 4 program, and (2) chapter 208 of the general statutes be amended to
- 5 allow a business tax credit in the amount of fifty per cent of any
- 6 donation made by a business to the foundation, provided that the total
- 7 amount of business tax credits granted for such donations shall not
- 8 exceed twenty-seven million dollars.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a foundation to receive donations for the Roberta B. Willis  
Scholarship program.
