"AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM FAIR WAGE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 31-58a of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

5 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (i) of section 31-58,
6 minors between the ages of sixteen and eighteen years who are
7 employees of the state or any political subdivision thereof shall be paid
8 a minimum wage of not less than eighty-five per cent of the minimum
9 fair wage as defined in said subsection, and notwithstanding the
10 provisions of said subsection, minors between the ages of fourteen and
11 eighteen who are agricultural employees shall be paid a minimum

12 wage of not less than eighty-five per cent of the minimum fair wage as
 13 defined in said section except agricultural employees between the ages
 14 of fourteen and eighteen who are employed by employers who did
 15 not, during the preceding calendar year, employ eight or more
 16 workers at the same time shall be paid a minimum wage of not less
 17 than seventy per cent of the minimum wage, as defined in said section
 18 31-58.

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (j) of section 31-58,
 20 as amended by this act, any person who qualifies as a seasonal
 21 employee under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act shall not be
 22 entitled to any increase in the minimum fair wage adopted on or after
 23 October 1, 2019."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
