"AN ACT MAKING CHANGES TO DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION ENFORCEMENT STATUTES."

1 Strike subsection (b) of section 2 in its entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) The Department of Consumer Protection shall furnish to each
4 qualified applicant a license certifying that the holder thereof is
5 entitled to engage in the work or occupation for which the person has
6 been issued a license under this chapter, and the holder of such license
7 shall carry it on his person while engaging in such work or occupation.
8 Such license shall be shown to any properly interested person on
9 request. No such license shall be transferred to or used by any person
10 other than the person to whom the license was issued. Contractors
11 [shall] that fail to display their state license number on all commercial
12 vehicles used in their business and [shall display such number] in a

13 conspicuous manner on all [printed] advertisements, bid proposals,
14 contracts, invoices and on all stationery used in their business may be
15 fined not more than five hundred dollars per violation, but shall not be
16 fined for the first violation. The department shall keep a register in
17 which shall be entered the names of all persons to whom such licenses
18 are issued. The register shall be at all times open to public inspection."
