"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2021, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET."

17 Strike section 316 in its entirety and renumber the remaining
18 sections and internal references accordingly

19 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
20 internal references accordingly:

21 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
22 and Management may allocate funds appropriated in section 1 of this
23 act to the Office of Policy and Management, for Private Provider Rate
24 Increase, to transfer available funds to affected agencies to effectuate
25 such rate increase.

26 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For the fiscal years ending June
27 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, all state employees who are not members
28 of a collective bargaining unit shall take three unpaid furlough days
29 per fiscal year.

30 (b) Any unpaid furlough days taken pursuant to this section shall be
31 treated as voluntary schedule reductions pursuant to the provisions in
32 effect on the effective date of this section, of (1) section 5-248c of the
33 general statutes, and (2) section 5-248c-3 of the regulations of
34 Connecticut state agencies, and wage credit for such days shall be in
35 accordance with the practice in effect on the effective date of this

36 section.

37 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) The State Contracting Standards
 38 Board shall develop a procurement plan for state contracting agencies
 39 to achieve twenty-five million dollars in savings for the fiscal year
 40 ending June 30, 2020, and twenty-five million dollars in savings for the
 41 fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Not later than August 1, 2019, the
 42 State Contracting Standards Board shall submit such plan to the
 43 Governor and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management
 44 for implementation of such plan. The Secretary of the Office of Policy
 45 and Management may make reductions in allotments to state
 46 contracting agencies during said fiscal years to achieve such savings.

47 Sec. 504. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
 48 and Management may make reductions in allotments to the
 49 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, for the fiscal
 50 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, in order to achieve
 51 privatization savings in the General Fund of \$2,250,000 during the
 52 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and \$4,250,000 during the fiscal year
 53 ending June 30, 2021.

54 Sec. 505. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Administrative
 55 Services shall develop and implement a plan to provide the personnel,
 56 payroll, affirmative action and business office functions under section
 57 60 of public act 05-251 to additional state agencies, to achieve five
 58 million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and
 59 ten million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021."
