"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2021, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET."

- 20 "Sec. 334. (*Effective from passage*) The provisions of section 12-722 of
21 the general statutes shall not apply to any additional tax due as a result
22 of the changes made to subparagraph (B) of subdivision (20) of
23 subsection (a) of section 12-701 of the general statutes pursuant to
24 section 332 of this act, for the taxable or income year commencing on
25 or after January 1, 2019, but prior to the effective date of section 332 of
26 this act."

- 29 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
30 internal references accordingly:
- 31 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2019*) Notwithstanding the
32 provisions of chapter 157 of the general statutes, no grant authorized
33 under said chapter shall be paid during the fiscal years ending June 30,
34 2020, and June 30, 2021. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 157
35 of the general statutes and section 3-69a of the general statutes, all
36 moneys in the Citizens' Election Fund shall be transferred from said
37 fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal

38 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021.

39 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For the fiscal years ending June
40 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, all state employees who are not members
41 of a collective bargaining unit shall take three unpaid furlough days
42 per fiscal year.

43 (b) Any unpaid furlough days taken pursuant to this section shall be
44 treated as voluntary schedule reductions pursuant to the provisions in
45 effect on the effective date of this section of (1) section 5-248c of the
46 general statutes, and (2) section 5-248c-3 of the regulations of
47 Connecticut state agencies, and wage credit for such days shall be in
48 accordance with the practice in effect on the effective date of this
49 section.

50 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) The State Contracting Standards
51 Board shall develop a procurement plan for state contracting agencies
52 to achieve twenty-five million dollars in savings for the fiscal year
53 ending June 30, 2020, and thirty-five million dollars in savings for the
54 fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Not later than August 1, 2019, the
55 State Contracting Standards Board shall submit such plan to the
56 Governor and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management
57 for implementation of such plan. The Secretary of the Office of Policy
58 and Management may make reductions in allotments to state
59 contracting agencies during said fiscal years to achieve such savings.

60 Sec. 504. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
61 and Management may make reductions in allotments to the
62 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, for the fiscal
63 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, in order to achieve
64 privatization savings in the General Fund of \$2,250,000 during the
65 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and \$4,250,000 during the fiscal year
66 ending June 30, 2021.

67 Sec. 505. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Administrative
68 Services shall develop and implement a plan to provide the personnel,
69 payroll, affirmative action and business office functions under section

70 60 of public act 05-251 to additional state agencies, to achieve five
 71 million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and
 72 ten million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

73 Sec. 506. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) Each commissioner or chief of any
 74 budgeted agency, as defined in section 4-69 of the general statutes,
 75 shall implement a hard hiring freeze for the fiscal years ending June 30,
 76 2020, and June 30, 2021."
