"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2021, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET."

18 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
19 internal references accordingly:

20 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the
21 provisions of chapter 157 of the general statutes, no grant authorized
22 under said chapter shall be paid during the fiscal years ending June 30,
23 2020, and June 30, 2021. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 157
24 of the general statutes and section 3-69a of the general statutes, all
25 moneys in the Citizens' Election Fund shall be transferred from said
26 fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal
27 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021.

28 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) The State Contracting Standards
29 Board shall develop a procurement plan for state contracting agencies
30 to achieve twenty-five million dollars in savings for the fiscal year
31 ending June 30, 2020, and fifty-five million dollars in savings for the
32 fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Not later than August 1, 2019, the
33 State Contracting Standards Board shall submit such plan to the
34 Governor and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management
35 for implementation of such plan. The Secretary of the Office of Policy
36 and Management may make reductions in allotments to state
37 contracting agencies during said fiscal years to achieve such savings.

38 Sec. 503. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
39 and Management may make reductions in allotments to the

40 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, for the fiscal
41 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, in order to achieve
42 privatization savings in the General Fund of \$2,250,000 during the
43 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and \$4,250,000 during the fiscal year
44 ending June 30, 2021.

45 Sec. 504. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Administrative
46 Services shall develop and implement a plan to provide the personnel,
47 payroll, affirmative action and business office functions under section
48 60 of public act 05-251 to additional state agencies, to achieve five
49 million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and
50 ten million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

51 Sec. 505. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For the fiscal years ending June
52 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, all state employees who are not members
53 of a collective bargaining unit shall take three unpaid furlough days
54 per fiscal year.

55 (b) Any unpaid furlough days taken pursuant to this section shall be
56 treated as voluntary schedule reductions pursuant to the provisions in
57 effect on the effective date of this section, of (1) section 5-248c of the
58 general statutes, and (2) section 5-248c-3 of the regulations of
59 Connecticut state agencies, and wage credit for such days shall be in
60 accordance with the practice in effect on the effective date of this
61 section."
