**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2021, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET."**

1 In line T469, strike "15,400,000" and substitute "11,262,000" in lieu  
2 thereof

3 In line T469, strike "16,000,000" and substitute "11,862,000" in lieu  
4 thereof

5 In line T470, adjust AGENCY TOTAL accordingly

6 In line T612, adjust NET - GENERAL FUND accordingly

7 In line T1294, strike the two instances of "9,221,035" and insert  
8 "5,221,035" in lieu thereof

9 In line T1383, adjust TOTALS accordingly

10 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
11 internal references accordingly:

12 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30,  
13 2020: (1) Any amount paid to a town pursuant to sections 54 to 58,  
14 inclusive, of this act, shall be increased by two and five-tenths per cent;  
15 and (2) notwithstanding the provisions of section 10-262h of the  
16 general statutes, the amount a town is eligible to receive under said  
17 section shall be increased by two and five-tenths per cent.

18 (b) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021: (1) Any amount paid to  
19 a town pursuant to sections 54 to 58, inclusive, of this act, shall be  
20 increased by five per cent; and (2) notwithstanding the provisions of  
21 section 10-262h of the general statutes, the amount a town is eligible to  
22 receive under said section shall be increased by five per cent.

23 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For the fiscal years ending June  
24 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, all state employees who are not members  
25 of a collective bargaining unit shall take three unpaid furlough days  
26 per fiscal year.

27 (b) Any unpaid furlough days taken pursuant to this section shall be  
28 treated as voluntary schedule reductions pursuant to the provisions in  
29 effect on the effective date of this section of (1) section 5-248c of the  
30 general statutes, and (2) section 5-248c-3 of the regulations of  
31 Connecticut state agencies, and wage credit for such days shall be in  
32 accordance with the practice in effect on the effective date of this  
33 section.

34 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) The State Contracting Standards  
35 Board shall develop a procurement plan for state contracting agencies  
36 to achieve twenty-five million dollars in savings for the fiscal year  
37 ending June 30, 2020, and seventy-five million dollars in savings for  
38 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Not later than August 1, 2019, the  
39 State Contracting Standards Board shall submit such plan to the  
40 Governor and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management  
41 for implementation of such plan. The Secretary of the Office of Policy

42 and Management may make reductions in allotments to state  
43 contracting agencies during said fiscal years to achieve such savings.

44 Sec. 504. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy  
45 and Management may make reductions in allotments to the  
46 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, for the fiscal  
47 years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021, in order to achieve  
48 privatization savings in the General Fund of \$2,250,000 during the  
49 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and \$4,250,000 during the fiscal year  
50 ending June 30, 2021.

51 Sec. 505. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Administrative  
52 Services shall develop and implement a plan to provide the personnel,  
53 payroll, affirmative action and business office functions under section  
54 60 of public act 05-251 to additional state agencies, to achieve five  
55 million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, and  
56 ten million dollars in savings for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

57 Sec. 506. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) Each commissioner or chief of any  
58 budgeted agency, as defined in section 4-69 of the general statutes,  
59 shall implement a hard hiring freeze for the fiscal years ending June 30,  
60 2020 and June 30, 2021."
