"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2021, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET."

1 Strike section 228 in its entirety and renumber the remaining
2 sections and internal references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 17b-106 of the general statutes is
6 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
7 *1, 2019*):

8 (b) Effective July 1, [2011] 2019, the commissioner shall provide a
9 state supplement payment for recipients of Medicaid and the federal
10 Supplemental Security Income Program who reside in long-term care

11 facilities sufficient to increase their personal needs allowance to [sixty]
 12 seventy-two dollars per month. Such state supplement payment shall
 13 be made to the long-term care facility to be deposited into the personal
 14 fund account of each such recipient. For the purposes of this
 15 subsection, "long-term care facility" means a licensed chronic and
 16 convalescent nursing home, a chronic disease hospital, a rest home
 17 with nursing supervision, an intermediate care facility for individuals
 18 with intellectual disabilities or a state humane institution.

19 Sec. 502. Section 17b-272 of the general statutes is repealed and the
 20 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2019*):

21 Effective July 1, [2011] 2019, the Commissioner of Social Services
 22 shall permit patients residing in nursing homes, chronic disease
 23 hospitals and state humane institutions who are medical assistance
 24 recipients under sections 17b-260 to 17b-262, inclusive, 17b-264 to 17b-
 25 285, inclusive, and 17b-357 to 17b-361, inclusive, to have a monthly
 26 personal fund allowance of [sixty] seventy-two dollars.

27 Sec. 503. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) The amount appropriated in section
 28 1 of this act to the Judicial Department, for Youth Violence Initiative,
 29 for each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 2020, and June 30, 2021,
 30 shall be transferred to the Department of Social Services, for Medicaid,
 31 in each said fiscal year."
