## "AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF STYROFOAM TRAYS IN CONNECTICUT SCHOOLS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) Not later than July 1, 2020, 4 each school district, regional school district, regional vocational 5 technical school and constituent unit of higher education shall develop 6 a plan for discontinuing the use in such district, school or constituent 7 unit, as applicable, of trays made from expanded polystyrene. Such 8 plan shall require the district, school or constituent unit, as applicable, 9 to discontinue such use not later than July 1, 2021, and to prepare for 10 the termination or amendment of any contract for the purchase of such 11 trays not later than July 1, 2020. Nothing in this section shall be 12 construed to require the development of such plan in any school 13 district, regional school district, regional vocational technical school or 14 constituent unit of higher education that discontinues the use of such 15 trays in such school district, school or constituent unit prior to July 1,

16 2020. For purposes of this section, "expanded polystyrene" means

- 17 blown polystyrene and expanded and extruded foams that are
- 18 thermoplastic petrochemical materials utilizing a styrene monomer
- 19 and processed by any number of techniques including, but not limited
- 20 to, fusion of polymer spheres, injection molding, foam molding and
- 21 extrusion-blown molding."
