11 subdivision (3) of subsection (c) of this section to the joint standing

12 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
13 relating to the judiciary, in accordance with the provisions of section
14 11-4a of the general statutes; and (2) December 1, 2020, the executive
15 director of the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities, or
16 the executive director's designee, shall submit a report on the findings
17 and recommendations of the advisory committee with respect to
18 subdivisions (1), (2) and (4) of subsection (c) of this section to the joint
19 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
20 matters relating to the judiciary, in accordance with the provisions of
21 section 11-4a of the general statutes."
