"AN ACT CONCERNING TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM CONTRIBUTIONS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (7) of section 10-183b of the general statutes
4 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2019*):

6 (7) "Contributions" means amounts withheld pursuant to this
7 chapter and paid to the board by an employer from compensation
8 payable to a member. Prior to July 1, 1989, "mandatory contributions"
9 are contributions required to be withheld under this chapter and
10 consist of five per cent regular contributions and "one per cent
11 contributions". From July 1, 1989, to June 30, 1992, "mandatory
12 contributions" are contributions required to be withheld under this
13 chapter and consist of five per cent regular contributions and one per
14 cent health contributions. From July 1, 1992, to June 30, 2004,

15 "mandatory contributions" are contributions required to be withheld
 16 under this chapter and consist of six per cent "regular contributions"
 17 and one per cent health contributions. From July 1, 2004, to December
 18 31, 2017, "mandatory contributions" are contributions required to be
 19 withheld under this chapter and consist of six per cent regular
 20 contributions and one and one-fourth per cent health contributions.
 21 [On and after] From January 1, 2018, to December 31, 2019, inclusive,
 22 "mandatory contributions" are contributions required to be withheld
 23 under this chapter and consist of seven per cent "regular contributions"
 24 and one and one-fourth per cent health contributions. On and after
 25 January 1, 2020, "mandatory contributions" are contributions required
 26 to be withheld under this chapter and consist of seven per cent
 27 "regular contributions" and one and one-fourth per cent health
 28 contributions, except that no health contributions shall be required for
 29 an employee of the state that (A) has completed the vesting service
 30 necessary to receive health benefits provided to retired state
 31 employees, and (B) does not participate in any group health insurance
 32 plans maintained for retired teachers. Nothing in this subdivision shall
 33 affect any other obligation of such a state employee to contribute to the
 34 state's retiree health care trust fund. "Voluntary contributions" are
 35 contributions by a member authorized to be withheld under section
 36 10-183i."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
