3 "(NEW) (96) The Governor shall proclaim April sixteenth of each
4 year to be Advance Directive Awareness Day to raise public awareness
5 of the importance of planning ahead for health care decisions and to
6 encourage the use of advance directives. Suitable exercises may be
7 held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for
8 the observance of the day.

9 (NEW) (97) The Governor shall proclaim May sixth of each year to
10 be Moyamoya Awareness Day to raise public awareness of the
11 symptoms and available treatments for this cerebrovascular disease.

- 12 Suitable exercises may be held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as
- 13 the Governor designates for the observance of the day."
