**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING NET METERING, LONG-TERM CONTRACTS FOR CERTAIN CLASS I GENERATION PROJECTS, RENEWABLE ENERGY TARIFFS AND THE RESIDENTIAL SOLAR INVESTMENT PROGRAM AND REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE VALUE OF DISTRIBUTED GENERATION.

**Statement of Purpose:** To (1) require electric distribution companies to solicit and file with the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority long-term contracts with owners or developers of certain Class I generation projects for an additional year, (2) increase the total potential deployment pursuant to the residential solar investment program to four hundred megawatts, and (3) require a study of the value of solar.
