**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING NET NEUTRALITY PRINCIPLES AND INTERNET PRIVACY.

**Statement of Purpose:** To require Internet service providers to register and pay registration fees, to require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to apply net neutrality principles to Internet service providers and enforce such principles with civil penalties and to prohibit Internet service providers from taking certain actions with respect to a consumer's personally identifying information.
