Title: AN ACT CONCERNING A MARKETING PLAN TO PROMOTE THE BIOSCIENCE INDUSTRY IN THE STATE.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) eliminate the capital base tax for companies with less than five hundred thousand dollars of net income in an income year; (2) eliminate the cap on the aggregate amount of tax credits and excess tax credits allowable to businesses subject to the corporation business tax; (3) require the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to implement the development, research and economic assistance matching grant program; (4) require Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated to contract with an advertising agency to develop a marketing plan, social media campaign, and Internet web site to promote the state as a bioscience hub; and (5) establish the position of biotechnology ambassador within the Department of Economic and Community Development.
