Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

There is a potential revenue gain to municipalities resulting from the amendment, which prohibits a full service restaurant from providing customers plastic straws unless the customer requests one. Violating the provisions of the amendment results in a \$25 fine per day (with a maximum annual violation of \$300) if enforced. To the extent that municipalities choose to enforce violations, it is expected that any revenue gain would be less than \$2,000 annually.
