### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, the amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to study commercially available single-use checkout bags. As DEEP has expertise in materials management this provision is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact.

It also requires grocery stores to provide only compostable produce bags, on and after October 1, 2021 (FY 22) as certified by the Office of Policy and Management. This is also not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact.
