Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact. The amendment makes it a class E felony to possess, own, buy, sell transfer, or manufacture animal fighting paraphernalia with the intent to engage in, wage upon, promote, facilitate animal fighting and results in a potential cost for incarceration or probation supervision and a potential revenue gain from fines.
